STUDENTS INFORMATION VERIFICATION FORM

In September, the school sends home Student Verification Forms for parents/guardians to look over and sign. This form contains important information about your child that includes current home address, phone numbers, medical information, allergies, etc. It is vital that this information is up to date for each school year. If you change your phone number throughout the year, please let the office know right away, so that in case of emergency or illness we can contact you. Please return all the forms to the classroom teacher as soon as possible.

E-CONSENT

Earelier this week, you received 3 emails with eConsent forms. These forms are **very important** and are different that the Student Information Verification form (which is kept in the school office) that was sent home last week as a paper form.

• Student Emergency Release:

These forms are printed and kept in our emergency Kiosk in case of an emergency where we would have to evacuate the school. They are used to determine who you have identified are able to pick up your children in the event of an emergency. If this form is not completed your children will remain at the school until you are able to pick them up.

• Cloud Consent:

This consent allows your child to use a chromebook/ipad to access the internet and various applications. Please see the form for more information.

• Student Information Consent:

This form contains various other permissions. Most importantly photo permissions and walking field trip. Please contact the school office if you have any questions or concerns.

THE USE OF PERSONAL DEVICES AT SCHOOL:



To align with the ministry mandate, regarding the use of personal devices during school hours, we will have restrictions on personal digital devices when classes resume starting September 3rd, 2024. At école Quarterway, personal digital devices are now restricted throughout the instructional day (start of day bell to dismissal bell.) This includes class time, recess, lunch, and supervision time on school grounds before the welcome bell. Devices must be turned off or placed on airplane mode and kept it away for the entire school day. We thank you for your cooperation on this important matter.
